"My top priorities for the year are to continue to improve upon the amazing foundation that has been established these last two years," Vaill said. "Building and strengthening relationships with staff, students, families, community members and all stakeholders is a focus."

She also likes the positive school culture and wants to continue to expand that with more student and parent events, more community partnerships that lead to internships, jobs, and experiences for Freedom students.

As a founding staff member of the Freedom Institute, she began as a Senior Success Coach in 2023. She's passionate about fostering strong relationships and a positive school culture where every student feels supported, inspired, and empowered to succeed.

"I love everything about Freedom, and have from day one," she said. "So, it's easy to maintain what has already been built, because I'm truly passionate about our program and collaborated with our team to get us to the place we are now."

In a pioneering move, the Freedom Institute has also appointed Nathan Poteet as the Executive Director of Programs and Artificial Intelligence to lead its AI integration strategy. Students and teachers alike will benefit from personalized learning pathways, intelligent tutoring systems, and advanced digital tools that enhance not replace human instruction.

"Our goals for this year include certifying many of our current students in Artificial Intelligence, while also laying the groundwork to offer certification opportunities to

educators and other external participants in the future," Poteet said. "We are currently piloting an Al-focused high school program with 10 students, who are receiving their curriculum through a variety of instructional methods. Each course includes embedded Al modules on a weekly basis. We plan to significantly expand all programs in the upcoming year."

One of the driving forces behind the Freedom Institute's success is its tailored approach to education. That same approach will be used with the addition of AI.

"As with all aspects of learning at Freedom, students play a central role in shaping their educational experience," Poteet said. "Our approach is fully student-centered, with each class tailored to meet the unique needs, interests, and goals of every individual learner. We believe that meaningful learning happens when students have a voice in their education, which is why we actively seek and incorporate their feedback on a weekly basis. This ongoing dialogue allows us to adapt our instruction in real time, ensuring that our courses remain relevant, engaging, and aligned with each student's personal and academic goals."
